Rev. Dale A. Meyer, former speaker of the Lutheran Hour and current president of Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, tells a story about a volunteer who was searching for a minister in the hurricane devastation of the Gulf Coast area. This man was trying to drive through a subdivision to find the home of a certain minister. House numbers were of little help because the houses in that subdivision had been moved around by the storm surge. When he saw a man standing in his driveway, he approached and said he was looking for pastor so-and-so. "You found him," the man said.

Picture that...A man standing before his ruined home. Standing there and thinking. Thinking only his thoughts and maybe thinking about God, maybe.

As I look back in history, I assume this has been the case with many people in the midst of tragedy in their life. As I write, I'm sure many are lost in their thoughts like this pastor; the many in Nebraska who have nothing because of floods and the Christians in Sri Lanka whose Easter was a day of mourning rather than joy.

Maybe you have experienced that moment in your life. Just standing. Standing before brokenness. Just standing there and thinking. Thinking all alone with your thoughts. Weighed down by the unfairness of so much in life. Sometimes you are alone wrestling with the unfair way God seems to treat you.

Wouldn't it be great if we could add a little sugar to those times in life? A little sweetener and cream? Sometimes the bitter hours of our life need a little sugar.

Take enough time alone with God and He'll add the sweetener. Maybe it'll come in reading your Portal of Prayers or your Bible. Maybe a favorite hymn or Bible passage memorized long ago will add that sugar cube you've needed. Maybe it will be from participating in Bible Study or a small group study.

The sweetener is the Spirit of Jesus, who suffered unjustly but gives hope by His resurrection. God says, "Friend, I am not being unfair to you, I am with you" (Matthew 20:13, 28:20).

Your thoughts sweetened? If not, be sure to read some more from The Book that gives life its sweetener.
