Wow! What. A. Week.

The youth that Trinity sponsored for the National Youth Gathering had a crazy week in Minneapolis learning about our Real, Present, God. Much has happened since then, and the youth are excited to serve the Lord and His church all the more.

There were about 22,000 youth and volunteers who packed U.S. Bank Stadium, where the Minnesota Vikings play football. They made friends from across the nation. They dove into the Bible, specifically the Psalms. They explored a new city. They even survived the mosquitos!

As they traveled back home from the Gathering, the youth were challenged with what they would do with all they learned about in their encounter with the Real. Present. God. They heard his Word through a variety of engaging speakers. They sang His praise with thousands of people during Mass Events. They spoke to Him in prayer. They tasted His body and blood in a massive worship service. They experienced the life-giving forgiveness of sins through the death and resurrection of the Son of God.

As a congregation, I encourage you to remind those who went to the National Youth Gathering that the Real, Present, God goes with them. Encourage them to be reminded that He goes with them as they gather together around his Word. He goes with them as they worship and commune with our congregation. He goes with them as they come to Him in prayer and praise.

I also encourage you to remind these youth that everything isn't only about them, but as they learned, it's about the people God has put (and will put) in their life. The impact of the Gathering extends beyond them and our youth group as He works through them in real and present ways.

As you encourage the youth, do not be surprised if they in turn encourage you also. For their faith has been emboldened to speak of His Word through the Holy Spirit. Do not be surprised if the youth begin to remind you that God uses YOU to bring his love to more people. He uses YOU to heal relationships with words of forgiveness. He uses YOU to bring peace in times of struggle. He uses YOU to speak God's promises in Christ to those who need God's safety and security.

This may seem intimidating...overwhelming...maybe even impossible. If that's what you're thinking, you're right. But God is Real and Present here, too. He will use YOU to impact others with his life-giving promises in Jesus! Because of Jesus, 1






