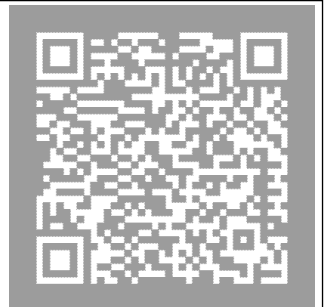
We are praying special prayers for:

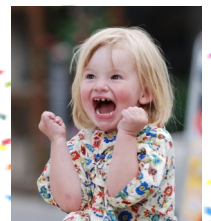
