Trinity Lutheran now offers a mobile version of our online giving page to make it easy for you to give anytime from your smart phone. Last month was Sanctity of Human Life Month. And if you are like me, you might have been embedded with your own problems that caused you to de-sanctify life by thinking, "Why doesn't God just take me home? I'd be better off dead."

During the season of winter, life can seem to be a burden. I don't know if it's the cold, the lack of light or being cooped up in the house all the time. It's during this time that life can be depressing and we begin to think "de-sanctifying" things.

We've all thought it, "He'd be better off dead." It's a response that our society is saying more and more. A response directed toward those who are getting older or just can't do much anymore. So, is it true? Would we be better off dead?

Surprisingly from a Scriptural point of view, the answer is Yes. We as disciples of Christ would all be better off dead, for it was the apostle Paul himself who wrote "I desire to depart and be with Christ which is better by far" (Philippians 1:23). Paul can say this for it was true. Paul knew because of what Christ had done on the cross that he was going to a better place with Christ when his earthly life ended. We can also say this for it is Christ's presence in our death that comforts, and gives us patience as we wait for this day. But, Paul does not stop there and neither should we.

Death is not the only possibility for Paul. In fact Paul says that it is "more necessary" to keep living, for God has additional plans. These additional plans require for us to live. Paul says "to live is Christ" (Phil. 1:21). Therefore living is required for the additional plans of our Lord, which Paul will later describe as "fruitful labor".

This is also true for you. No matter how young or old you may feel. No matter if you are ill or even unconscious, God is keeping you alive. Whether life or death, as long as our Lord gives life, He gives "fruitful labor" for us to accomplish. This "fruitful labor" causes others great joy which overflows in Christ Jesus (Philippians 1:26).

It is a tragedy to think that the Lord is unable to do anything great or even minimal in our lives. But we as sinners often think this way and forget that it is God and His presence in our life that accomplishes "fruitful labor." We often limit the power of God and say, "God can only

work in young and healthy people." To this silly thought I proclaim to you that "He's God! Let Him be!"

Better off Dead? Yes... but, let Christ be exalted by letting Him work in us until our day is done. It is better off by far for the Christian to depart and be with Christ. But for right now it is more necessary that you go on living. Go on living for the Lord!



New Member Class!! Mondays beginning on February 3rd at 6:30p.m. In Pastor's office The class will run for 6 weeks. Blessings as we close the books on 2019 and look forward to a prosperous 2020. Trinity entered the month of November with offerings trailing 2018's total by \$5,986. With your love and commitment to serving Christ, November and December offerings reversed this negative trend resulting in 2019 total offerings of \$371,923, an increase of \$27,428 from 2018 total offerings. THANK YOU!

There are a few adjustments to be made before final figures are available, but Trinity finished the year with approximately a \$40,000 deficit compared to 2018's \$42,000 deficit. Progress has been made,



but I ask that you continue to prayerfully consider accepting the giving challenge for all 12 months of 2020. The yearend outstanding debt on the newly named operating note was roughly \$39,000.

I ask that the congregation join me in thanking Tammy Lampe for her seven years of service as Trinity's Financial Secretary. Often times these positions go unnoticed, but play a very important role in the functions of the Church. Thank you Tammy for your dedication to the position and your continued assistance in training our new Financial Secretary, Nancy Briggeman. Thank you Nancy for being willing to step into this role.



1/2 tsp nutmeg


Mix, heat in microwave until dissolved and blended.
