Friends in Christ,

Soon we will begin the penitential season of Lent. Lent is a time to reflect upon one's sinful life and to repent of sin. In biblical times, some people would demonstrate their repentance by donning ashes as a symbol of their guilt and mortality. This we will do beginning on Ash Wednesday. But Lent is not only a time to see our sin; it is also a season for beholding our Savior. It is a time to hear his Word. During this Lenten season, we will listen to the words spoken by Jesus from the cross. These are his "CrossWords".

During these next few weeks of Lent we will devote ourselves to reflect upon the suffering and death of Christ. But Lent is also a time to hear afresh the words of the Lord. As Jesus attested: "The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life" (John 6:63). It is appropriate during this season, therefore, to give attention to the words of life that Jesus spoke while in the very midst of death.

Primarily we will be meditating on the seven sayings of Jesus that He spoke from the cross. These words that are spoken have been traditionally reserved for Good Friday. This is done in the context of the Tre Ore service (*Tre Ore* is Italian for "three hours," referring to the three hours that darkness settled upon the land during Christ's crucifixion). This service traditionally is conducted from noon to three o'clock in the afternoon on that holy day. The Tre Ore involves readings and homilies that reflect upon the seven last sayings of Christ from the cross.

With that being said, we will be hearing His "CrossWords" each Sunday in the Lenten season. We will be bringing a part of the Tre Ore service to each service on Sunday. Below is a schedule that we plan to follow up to Easter. The Lord bless you as you set aside the time the Lord has given you to be with His people and in His Word.

Operating Loan Challenge!


A member has offered to match dollar for dollar through April 1st, any contributions made toward paying off our operating loan of \$14,178.33.



Pastor Santi Keinbaum was born into an Austro-Hungarian-Spanish immigrant family on 3/27/1974 in Montevideo, Uruguay. As a young adult, and because of his European citizenship, he settled in Barcelona, Catalonia (Spain), a place that he knew very well because of all the family roots he had there and many travels he took there before he moved. There he met Alex, his wife. The Lord blessed this union with 3 children: Maria (17), Santi Jr (16), and Salva (14). In the year 2000, Pastor Santi was involved in the Lutheran Church-Missouri Synod led Mission in Spain. He became a key leader for the mission work in the Barcelona area. In 2009, through a series of God-directed events,



Pastor Santi was given the opportunity to initiate theological training in the USA. After completing all the academic requirements, Pastor Santi was accepted at Concordia University, Nebraska, where he was awarded a full international scholarship. At Concordia, he completed several theology, music, art, and education classes as well as pre-seminary classes, including his favorite theological languages, Greek and Latin. In 2013 he was accepted at Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne, Indiana, where he received a Master of Divinity degree in 2017. He is tremendously thankful to the Lord for his wife and children who are unconditionally supporting him and who, by the grace of God, are the main reason why he can exercise his pastoral vocation with much gladness.
