Dear friend in Christ,

April 4 is Easter Day. It is likely that, by the time you receive this newsletter, you either are about to enter into the Easter Season or you are already in it. We were holding our Hallelujahs and Easter salutation for long weeks. At last, we can rejoice about our risen Savior and give Him all the praises and Hallelujahs! Christ is risen, indeed!

Our Christian faith is grounded in holy baptism, and baptism is wrapped in this fact, that because Jesus was risen so you too will rise. The resurrection promise that Jesus brings must be heard from our pulpits, not just occasionally, but over and over. What is the purpose of the Father sending the Son into the world? Was it not to give the human race a Savior that would rescue all who believe from the snare and pangs of hell? Was it not to assure an ongoing cleansing of the heart as you struggle with your own brokenness? Was it not to receive the gift of righteousness by means of the work of Jesus on the cross?

Yes, of course, the cross of Jesus is the source of God's mercy, even as we celebrate His resurrection. There cannot be a resurrection without His death on the cross, and there cannot be a resurrection without the restoration that forgiveness brings. After all, "where there is forgiveness of sins, there is also life and salvation", and where there is salvation our own resurrection from the dead becomes an undeniable fact. It is in the forgiveness of sins that you can find the beauty of the crucifixion of Jesus and the majesty of His resurrection.

Dear friend in Christ, just hold tight to His unfailing promises and keep on believing with that baptismal faith that you received. It is through the lenses of that faith that the Word of God becomes an absolute truth, an absolute comfort, and a fundamental part of your Christian identity. It is with that faith that you can experience the power of His resurrection in you, that because He is risen and lives, you also will be raised and never die (John 11:25-26).

Christ is risen! He is risen, indeed! Hallelujah!
