Two brothers were caught stealing sheep. Their punishment was severe, both were branded on their foreheads with the letters "ST," which stood for Sheep Thief. The shame was unbearable for the older brother. He became a wanderer, going from town to town, always keeping his hat pulled down over his forehead to hide the "ST." The only escape that he could find was in a bottle. He died younger than a person should, a lonely wreck of a man.

The other brother had the "ST" on his forehead but decided to stay in town, not to run away. The first years were difficult, publicly shamed for his crime, but he stuck it out. He strove to lead a normal life, not only going out into the public but actually becoming a model citizen. - <u>ALL</u> payment requests are to be presented <u>only</u> to the Bookkeeper. If Bookkeeper is not in the office, a detailed note (i.e., whether it needs to be mailed or will be picked up; if there is a certain date the check is needed by; etc.) might need to be attached and placed in the Bookkeeper Office Mail Slot.
- All receipts and invoices presented for payment need to be SIGNED by whoever made the purchase or whoever accepted the invoice. Invoices or receipts should be labeled as to what event or purpose the purchase was made.
- A minimum of <u>3 bookkeeper working days</u> should be allowed for check completion. They currently are Tues-Thurs 8:30am-3:30pm and Friday 8:30am-12:00pm.
- The Treasurer is a volunteer who will be in to sign checks on Sunday morning, and additionally Wednesday evenings during the school year.


We still have space for students to join us if you know of anyone. Trinity Lutheran Church Endowment generously gifted us so half of your monthly tuition will be paid for with this
