And while they were gazing into heaven as he went, behold, two men stood by them in white robes, and said, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking into heaven? This Jesus, who was taken up from you into heaven, will come in the same way as you saw him go into heaven." (Acts 1:9-11)

Ascension Day is shortly upon us! It is a glorious day in the Church in which we celebrate that our Lord ascends to the right hand of God the Father, Almighty.

To celebrate **Ascension Day**, we will be having a joint outdoor worship service with Trinity, Immanuel and Grace Lutheran in the great town of Deerfield, KS at Deerfield Park on 8th Street and Main as we did last year. This park is across from the former Lutheran church in Deerfield. We will be celebrating this festival with the Lord's Supper on **Thursday**, **May 26**, **2022**, **at 6:30pm**.

The Ascension of our Lord serves as a preview of our future. As Jesus ascended to heaven at the conclusion of His earthly sojourn, so we by faith anticipate with expectant joy that time when He will return to bring us to be where He is. Ascension Day is a great celebration of the Church and a time for abundant rejoicing by all of our Lord's faithful people!

The Lutheran Church has traditionally celebrated the Ascension to emphasize that Christ's ascension to the right hand of the Father gave Him the power and authority to deliver exactly what He has promised—His body and His blood given for you and me to eat and to drink for the forgiveness of sins. His ascension into heaven marks His nearness to us. While Christ may not be visible to us in His body, as He was to His disciples, He is visible to us in the Sacraments, where He places Himself behind the bread and the wine, and giving to us His very body and blood. In the Lord's Supper, Christ gives to us the very same body that ascended into heaven and now "sits at the right hand of the Father." It is with the authority given to Him that He now gives us His body and His blood to strengthen our faith and to preserve us until He returns in glory, when all will see Him face to face.

This coming Ascension Day come out to Deerfield, across from the location where Lutheranism had its beginning in Southwest Kansas. Come and recall what Jesus accomplished for you. When He ascended into heaven, He received all authority in heaven and on earth so that He can draw near to you and deliver to you what He has promised. Recall how His ascension means that Jesus is not far from you, but so close that He puts His very body and blood into your mouth for the forgiveness of your sins. In the Lord's Supper, Jesus draws closer to you than He was to the Virgin Mary when He dwelled in her womb. His ascension means He can do exactly what He promises. Indeed, the ascension of Christ into heaven marks one of the most important holidays in the church year. Be sure not to miss it.
