We recently celebrated Trinity Sunday. Some of us were waiting for it since last year because there is something special about the Trinity Sunday Service: We get to profess the Athanasian Creed!

The name of this Creed is attributed to Athanasius of Alexandria, who became the great champion of the trinitarian orthodoxy in a moment when the Church was attacked by the heresy of Arianism in the 4th century.

The Arian heresy led to a theological debate that had its core in the nature of Christ which, at the same time, led to the creation of the Nicene Creed in 325 AD. Was Christ of the same substance of the Father? Was the Holy Spirit of the same substance as the Son and the Father? Hundreds of bishops who were gathered, ended up affirming the Greek term “homoousios” or ‘of the same substance,” a phrase that became part of our profession of Christian faith as reflected in both the Nicene and Athanasian Creeds. We believe, according to the Nicene Creed, that our Lord Jesus Christ is “of one substance with the Father and, in the same way, we believe, according to the Athanasian Creed, that “we worship one God in Trinity and Trinity in unity, neither confusing the persons nor dividing the substance.”

Built upon the Nicene Creed, the teachings coming out of the Athanasian Creed are of a tremendous and foundational value to our Christian faith. The first sentence of this Creed states the following: “Whoever desires to be saved must, above all, hold the catholic faith.” Excuse me? Catholic faith? Nah, nah, I’m Lutheran! Ok, I know. We are Lutherans but also... catholics. Yes, Lutheran catholics. You might be asking yourself, did pastor go nuts? No. Just relax. It’s all good. Let me explain.

The word “catholic” (note the lowercase “c”) is a Greek word meaning “general” or “universal.” It does not refer to the Roman Catholic church but to the general or universal Christian Church. So, we can say we are catholic Lutherans in the sense that we belong to the universal Christian Church. For various reasons, we do not usually use the word “catholic.” We do not want to cause confusion among the Christian Church at large or to those who are yet to join the Church.

But we, with the whole Christian Church, do subscribe and hold to the catholic (please read: general, universal Christian) faith which is founded and empowered by our most blessed Triune God, Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Where the Triune God is not believed and professed, there cannot be eternal life. When man rejects the Trinity, he puts himself in the path of perdition, and begins to walk toward the abyss of hell. That is not God’s desire for mankind, for God so loved world....

Our faith resides in the conviction that our Triune God is the true and only God, fully capable to create, to redeem, and to sanctify. This is the true God who is revealed to us in the Holy Bible. In this Triune God we believe and are firmly set in His hands, in which we are protected, cared for, and comforted by His mercies which are new every morning.

For some of us, we will need to wait almost a full year to get to profess the Athanasian Creed again. We will wait, but in the meantime, we will continue to believe in and be the recipients of the marvelous works of the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost, as we continue to walk as Christians, catholic Lutherans, as sons and daughters of the Most High Triune God.
