It used to be that our cars could drive themselves to Sunday worship for the purpose of hearing the Word and receiving the Sacrament and responding in prayer. It is the same through all of America, whether it is in Missouri, Tennessee, Ohio, Florida or rural Kansas, I hear the same phrase, "Well Pastor,... You know,... I've been pretty busy."

If I may be so bold, let me kindly remind you, "Brother, the grass grows on your path." You are no longer listening to God's command to worship and pray, and you are unwilling to recognize His answer to your prayers. And yet our Lord still wants you to be where His Word is found. He pleads for you to be in conversation with Him. Our Lord says in the Gospel of Matthew,

"Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened" (Matthew 7:7-8).


