Psalm 23:1, "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want."

Psalm 23 is the most well-known psalm of the entire Scriptures. Oftentimes when I read these words at the bedside of a parishioner there is an emotional response to God's grace. The words of this psalm portray the beautiful imagery of the Shepherd and His sheep. Jesus is the Good Shepherd (John 10), and He has been sent by His heavenly Father to tend His sheep. From the moment the Holy Spirit gave you the gift of faith either in the waters of Baptism and through the hearing of the Word, you became a part of God's family, His flock. You are God's sheep! When evil visits you, you are God' sheep. When joy fills your heart, you are God's sheep!

Even though we are clothed with Christ in Baptism; even though we are His very own sons and daughters, the sinful nature still lurks in our lives. That's why, as His flock, we can exhibit those sheep characteristics. The devil, the world, and our sinful nature try to destroy our faith in Christ. These outside influences oftentimes will lure God's sheep to the other side of the fence. Perhaps there is something we see that we want to do, and it takes us away from the Lord's pasture. Or we may experience some shocking event or rejection by a loved one that doesn't make sense when we've been committed and faithful.

The sheep's natural response is to wander. In sin we wander from God's house—become angry with Him, lose faith in Him, lose confidence that His simple Word and Sacraments are the richest means anyone could ever spread before us. The next thing we know—a missed Sunday here and a missed Sunday there—turns into weeks and weeks into months and months into years without ever being fed with the nourishment of God. The grace of God found in the 23rd Psalm is forgotten.

That's why God sent His only Son to be your Savior. He has died for all of your sins upon the Cross and has been bodily raised from the dead for you on the Third Day for your forgiveness, life, and salvation. This Good Shepherd knows you by name. By faith, your name is now written in His Book of Life. It's this relationship between the Shepherd and His sheep that will last for an eternity. He prepares His table for you—His true body and blood given and shed for you to eat and drink for the forgiveness of our sins and the strengthening of your faith—and invites you to come and dine as His guests.

This next month there will be multiple opportunities for you to be a lamb close to your Shepherd. Look at this newsletter and seek the Lord in prayer to seek and see what He may have you do in order to draw even closer to Him.

As we draw near Him and feed on the Shepherd's love given to us in the Word and Sacraments, and as we stay with His flock, He breaks the old willfulness and stubbornness. He makes us His servants, who fear, love and trust in Him above all things. He makes us His servants who willingly lay down our lives for the needs of others and for the sake of His Gospel message.

The February 20, 2023 meeting of the Trinity Lutheran Church Endowment Board was called to order by President, Gerry Schultz at 5:05. Pastor Hageman led us in a devotion (see attachment) and prayer.

Jay moved to approve the minutes from the previous meeting with the following amendments:

Delete #8 from re-allocations and change the amount from #26 on allocations from \$10,

0700.00 to \$10,700.00. James seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jay moved and James seconded for Brenda Drees to be elected secretary. Motion carried.

Jay reviewed the financial report (see attachment). James moved we accept the treasurer's

reports and Jay seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jay reviewed the allocation report from the previous year. Jay moved we accept the report, James seconded and motion carried.

President Gerry Schultz then reviewed the process for the evening. We will review each request with full discussion and approve the allocations and re-allocations as an entirety.

The investment losses for 2022 were \$279,687.00 so no new funds are available for allocation.

All requests have been forwarded to the members of the Board.

The Endowment Board members were prayerfully given the following challenge:

\$72, 937 funds that were not used last year and to be reallocated for this year and \$42, 574 for new projects for a total of \$115, 511.00.

During discussion for re-allocation, Jay passed out a hand-out on TIG funding (see attachment).

The following funds were re-allocated:

- 1. Pastor's Mike request for Youth Camps for \$2, 500.
- 2. TIG Ministry for \$15, 830.00
- 3. TLC Pre-School ABCD Board for any unused funds for 2022 for \$7,690.00.

Total Approved for Re-allocation: \$26,020.00. Funds for Allocation for 2023 approved were:

Jay moved to approve \$26,020.00 in total re-allocations, \$18,650.00 in allocations and to place \$23,924.00 in future projects. James seconded and motion passed unanimously.

Jay moved to recommend Brenda for another term in June 2023 as her term is expiring. James seconded and motion passed.

Jay presented the investment overview.

James moved and Jay seconded and the following was unanimously approved by the board:

"Jay Meyer shall be authorized to have control of, transfer and manage all funds of the Endowment Fund of Trinity Lutheran Church. Incidental thereto, Jay Meyer shall have access to all account information with Lutheran Extension Fund or Thrivent Financial and authority to sign any and all documents incidental thereto."

The Board further recommended that the President of the Congregation sign all account agreements or other documents to carry out the motion and resolution of the Board.

Jay moved the meeting be adjourned and James seconded the motion. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned with The Lord's Prayer.
