Whom Are You Watching For?

Jesus' disciples were thrilled; they had their Lord back with them once again! Since His resurrection, He had appeared to them and to others several times. The disciples were still a little confused though, when He told them to "wait for the gift [His] Father promised." (Acts 1:5)

Before Jesus' disciples were prepared for Him to leave them again,

"Jesus said to them, 'It is not for you to know the times or dates the Father has set by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you; and you will be my witnesses....'

"After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight." (Acts 1:9)

Can you imagine their bewilderment! Jesus had died... been buried... and then had risen from the dead. Once more He walked with them and taught them... but now... He'd disappeared up into a cloud, leaving them again. No wonder they stood there with their mouths agape in shock--looking into the sky where they'd seen Him disappear. They couldn't believe their own eyes!

It took "two men dressed in white" to bring them back to their senses.

"Men of Galilee,' the [men dressed in white] said, 'why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven.' " (Acts 1:11)

The disciples went to Jerusalem. Their eyes were no longer on the clouds; now they were **watching for** Jesus to show up again, somewhere, sometime. "Will it be today???" In the meantime, they waited; they prayed; they chose a twelfth disciple to take the place of the traitor Judas, who--in despair--had hanged himself when Jesus was crucified. Whom--and what--are we, you and I, **watching for**? Yes, we know the story: Jesus ascended into heaven. (We cannot begin to imagine the celebration when He returned to heaven, triumphant over sin, death, and the devil!) Heaven welcomed back the crucified, buried, then *risen, victorious Son of God*, our Savior... "the author and perfecter of our faith " And so "I at us fix our aves on losus - " (Hobrows 12:2)

faith." And so, "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus...." (Hebrews 12:2). Through His Word (the Bible) and the Sacraments (Baptism and Holy Communion) Jesus will lead us into His kind of lifestyle, teaching us to obey His and our Father as He does; how to spend our lives, our time and our abilities in the way He

modeled: that is, *for others*. In the Bible, we **watch for** how Jesus showed us His kind of selfless love to "neighbors"--the people around us. With joyful and generous hearts, we **watch for** and celebrate the "new life" Easter

brings us. With all who will listen to us, we share the message of the Cross and the Empty Tomb; with expectation, we keep **watching for** Jesus--until we see Him in heaven, face to face!

In the meantime, we remember Jesus' last words to His disciples: "You will be my witnesses...."

that statement is for you and me too!

--Too big a challenge?

God's Holy Spirit is with us, and in us, to help us learn about, and show, Jesus' love through our words and actions! **Watch for** Sunday School classes and Bible studies, where our relationships, our thoughts, our hearts, are fed and nourished on the Good News of Jesus' forgiveness and love; where God's love for us is taught, talked about, learned, shared, experienced.
