"I'm falling apart, I've gotta put it all back together"

It's summer and in my mind things are supposed to slow down. It's when I can start tying up loose ends. More sunshine means getting things done. However, you know just as well as I do that the stresses and strains of life, even in the summer leave you feeling as if you're about to come apart. You know better than anyone else that your appearing to have it all together is a façade. You look all put together, but so did Humpty Dumpty sitting on the wall.

Jesus and His disciples were so busy that they couldn't even find time to eat. Time to get away for a group retreat! "Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest awhile" (Mark 6:31). When people and work have you ready to "come apart," do just that – come apart with Jesus. "You will find rest for your souls" (Matthew 11:29).

Well, it sounded like a good idea; the retreat. The disciples with Jesus set off but "many saw them going and recognized them, and they ran thee on foot from all the towns and got there ahead of them" (Mark 6:33). I'm sure the disciples thought "Can't we get any time to ourselves?". However, pay attention to Jesus. He shows compassion, fed 5,000, and then "made his disciples get into the boat and go before Him to the other side...while he dismissed the crowd. And after he had taken leave of them, he went up on the mountain to pray" (Mark 6:45-46). The plan for the retreat hadn't worked out but Jesus remained determined that He would still "come apart" to be with His Father.

You too. When your family and coworkers can't get the rest you all know you need, come apart by yourself. A few minutes to meditate upon a Bible verse, a short walk during break, prayer without ceasing...find your own personal way to come apart. You'll then return to the stress with a renewed peace to share. However, that won't be enough. You still need a group retreat, a coming apart with family and friends. We call that "church," and that retreat is always no more than a few days away.

"All the kings horses and all the king's men / Couldn't put Humpty together again."

Word and Sacrament can! "You keep him in perfect peace whose mind is stayed on you" (Isaiah

26:3).

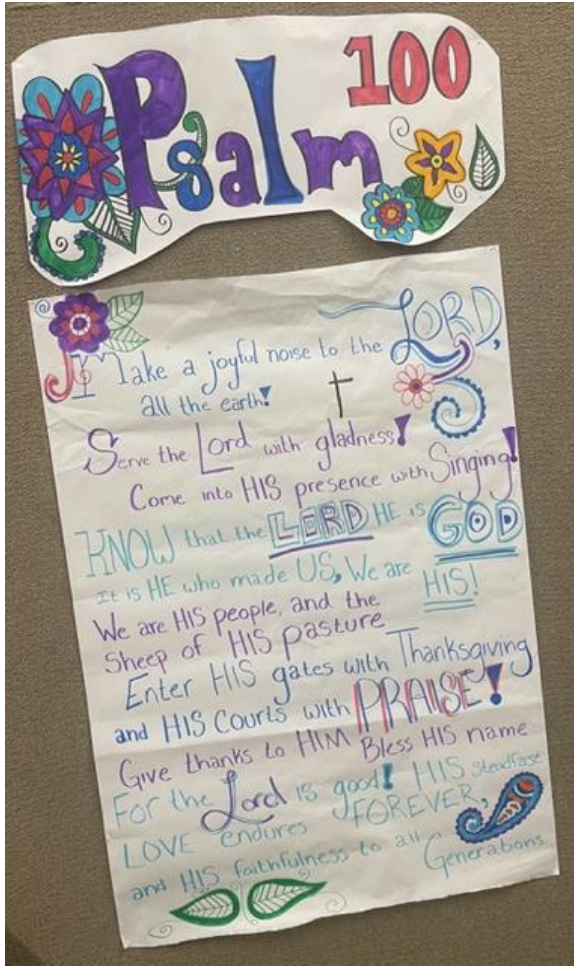
