Friends in Christ,

But these words seemed to them an idle tale, and they did not believe them. But Peter rose and ran to the tomb..." (Luke 24:11-12).

Today, I'm going to encourage you to "Run".

On that first Easter morning the wearied women who followed Jesus went to the tomb expecting to find death. Jesus had been beaten, crucified, dead and buried. Their pace laden by sorrow was slow as they made their way to the tomb. Their return trip to the disciples filled with fear and great joy was certainly swifter. As the women departed quickly and ran to tell the disciples that Jesus had been raised from the dead those gathered there thought it was an idle tale, "utter nonsense".

"Utter nonsense" is being told that someone rose from the dead. Another nonsensical idea? Running! Having run a few miles in my lifetime I have been reminded by others that running is utter nonsense!

In the resurrection story, Peter and John were around a disbelieving group when the women ran to them coming from the grave. Women running? Odd in that day and age. Yet the Scriptures say they ran and brought the Gospel truth. In the midst of unbelief the Spirit urged Peter and John to go and see this ridiculousness. They too ran.

Again and again the Spirit urges people to run to the tomb!

When circumstances of your life suggest that you're in a dead end...when friends and family disappoint you. When your prayers seem to go up and evaporate unanswered...when your heart and hope hit the ground with a thud... when words of faith seem like an idle tale...then the Spirit of God invites, "Run to the tomb"!

Our Lord rarely does things our way. He was born in a stable, not the palace of a king, rode into Jerusalem on a donkey, not a regal horse, died that we might live... He doesn't conform to our reasoned expectations. He's always going before us. Our joy is to follow.

Peter ran to the tomb because he remembered what Jesus had said. So too the women – "they remembered His Words" (Luke 24:8). In all you do this Easter season, remember God's promises to you and let the empty tomb resurrect your hope. Run and embrace Him (Luke 15:20). He has gifts to give. Run and hold fast to the Word of Life (Philippians 2:16). Sprint to the cup of our salvation (Psalm 116:13). Keep running to the tomb!

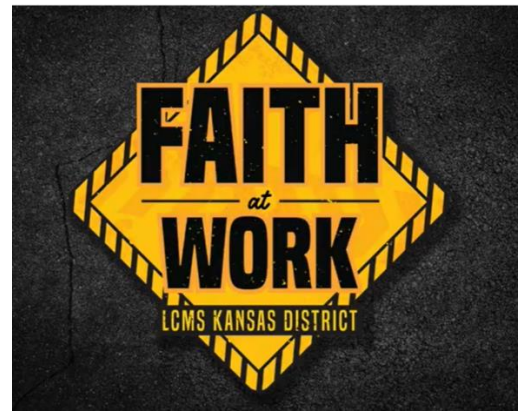

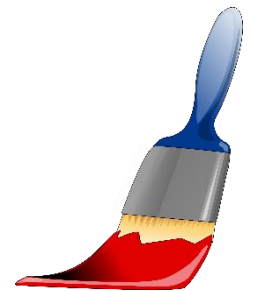

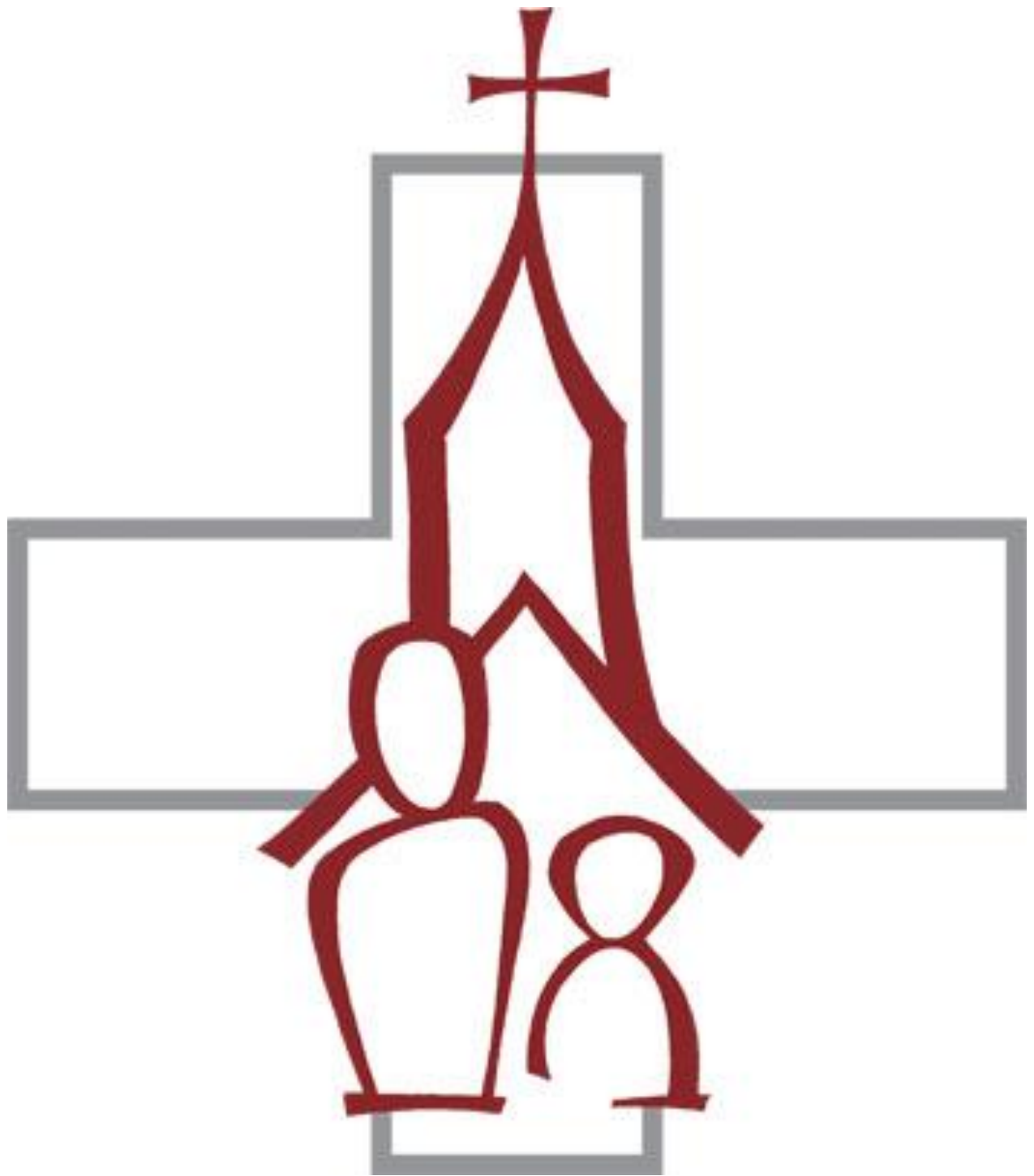
