"When God speaks, things happen." This was recently read at a meeting that I attended last month. It caught my attention for it was only a day before that I was teaching the same simple concept to our confirmation students. "God said, 'Let there be light'" (Genesis 1:3). Can you guess what happened?

Psalm 33:6 confidently confesses that "By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and by the breath of his mouth all their host."

They are only words. They are simple breathed out words and they are effective. They do things. These simple words deliver salvation.

This month we will be gathering together to celebrate how God's Word has had its way with many Lutherans in the Southwest Kansas area for many years. On October 20th, twelve of our congregations will come together at Holy Cross, Dodge City in order to hear God speak so that things may happen. What kind of words may these be? They are the forgiving kind of words and they will be given all afternoon on the 20th!

Martin Luther writes about these Gospel giving words when speaking about the Lord's Supper:

The words are the first thing, for without the words the cup and the bread would be nothing. Further, without bread and cup, the body and blood of Christ would not be there. Without the body and blood of Christ, the new testament would not be there. Without the new testament, forgiveness of sins would not be there. Without forgiveness of sins, life and salvation would not be there. Thus the words first connect the bread and the cup to the sacrament; bread and cup embrace the body and blood of Christ; body and blood of Christ embrace the new testament; the new testament embraces the forgiveness of sins; forgiveness of sins embraces eternal life and salvation. See, all this the words of the Supper offer and give us, and we embrace it by faith.

Luther says, "we embrace it by faith". Simple words proclaimed, simple faith receives and grasps onto that which is gifted for life and salvation.

Lord, we thank you for your simple powerful Word. May we hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it. Amen.

What a friend we have in Jesus, All our sins and griefs to bear!
What a privilege to carry, Everything to God in prayer!
Oh, what peace we often forfeit; Oh, what needless pain we bear-All because we do not carry, Everything to God in prayer!

Native Irishman (later living in Canada) Joseph Scriven (1819-86) seemed to have lived a difficult life, but was known to be a kind and generous man, and at times melancholy and eccentric. He battled childhood illness, the drowning of his fiance the night before their wedding, the loss of a second fiance, and depression. Through it he preached for the Plymouth Brethren and physically and financially took care of those in need. It was these hard times that likely influenced the words of this hymn, written for his mother as she was facing difficulty herself.

The hymn, loved by so many, has been critiqued as being weak in text and tune and "not great poetry" but Christians find true comfort in the simplicity of the message that we have a "friend in Jesus" and that "He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows" (Isaiah 53:4) and He can "sympathize with our weaknesses" (Hebrews 4:15).
