Romans 12:1, "I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship."

In this season of "thanksgiving," I want you to consider these 2 questions of generosity:

- 1) How has God blessed you with His generosity?
- 2) What is God calling you to do with this generosity?

First of all, let's begin where generosity rears its beautiful head. That location is at the cross. The cross is the epitome of generosity. It is from this location and act by our Savior that we conclude that generosity flows from the mercies of God. We messed everything up that He gave to us from the time of creation on account of our sin, yet He reconciles us to Himself (2 Cor. 5:18-19). What a difference maker this is! The Gospel changes our relationship with God. Through the gift of faith, we have been joined to the death and resurrection of Jesus. Our sins are forgiven. We have eternal life right now. This is where generosity begins.

Second, the generosity of God given now flows through us to others. The Gospel found at the cross changes our relationship with creation. We are called to be faithful in this life with what we have first been given by God. We are called to be faithful in this life with what we have first been given by God. You are baptized into the Name of Christ. Your identity is in Him. You daily live in your Baptism. When you confess your sins, God is faithful and just to forgive you through the cleansing blood of His Son. Washed in those waters, you are freed to serve Him as you serve others in daily life.

Responding to the mercies of God, you worship. You receive the gifts of God in Word and Sacrament. Jesus transforms your life through His means of grace given. What a benefit and blessing to receive His gifts of forgiveness, life, and salvation on a regular and continuing basis.

In your home, you work to feed your family; love and cherish your spouse; do the chores around the house and the yard; teach your children the Christian faith and how to pray; bring your family to the Divine Service and Sunday School.

In society, you work. You go to school. You pay taxes. You vote. You volunteer of your time in various service organizations. Filled with Jesus, look at how we are and can be generous in many different ways—at church, home, and society. You are baptized into the Name of Christ. That's always the starting point. Once we begin at that location, we are able to ask the following questions to encourage us in the Godly life of generosity.

- God has blessed us, what does this look like in your individual homes?
- God has blessed us, what does it look like in our congregational family?
- God has blessed us, what does it look like in with the people God places before you each day??

Give thanks to God for His many blessings given to you. Give thanks to God and consider how He can and wants to use you to serve others in His Kingdom!

Singing the Reformation

One of the central figures of church music during the Reformation period was Martin Luther, who expressed on numerous occasions that, next to theology, he accorded music the highest praise. In contrast to other notable reformers of his day, Luther believed that music was “a gift of God to be nurtured and used by man for his delight and edification, as a means for giving praise to the Creator, and as a vehicle for the proclamation of God’s Word.” It follows suit that the liturgical singing and hymnody that took place was and still is one of the most significant influences of Luther upon the worship life of the Lutheran church (and many other churches as well).
